- The project consists of a Mural to be painted on the west side of the Extra Space Property located at 2590 Military Road, Town of Niagara, NY. The Property is owned by Sonny Granger of Granger Development and has offered the property when he asked what he could do for the community. After some thought the Mural idea came about and we have been working for months on what, who, funding, etc.
- 2. The mural will provide direct visibility and inclusion of the Niagara River Greenway Trails visible from the NYS Thruway, the City of Niagara Falls, Canadian traffic to and from the Lewiston-Queenston Bridge and all the local traffic of tourists, residents and business on Military/Packard Road, the busiest intersection in Niagara County.
- 3. Toal Project Cost for Artist is \$108,100.00. The Town of Niagara Beautification Committee has paid for the design and the canvas/building of the artwork is donated by Granger Development.
- 4. Letters of support are attached. The Niagara Wheatfield students will be taking part in this project by painting the background of the mural.
- 5. A conceptual design is attached.
- 6. If approved, the plan is to start the project in early spring as soon as the weather conditions are conducive to painting. It will take approximately 2 months to complete. (2025)




